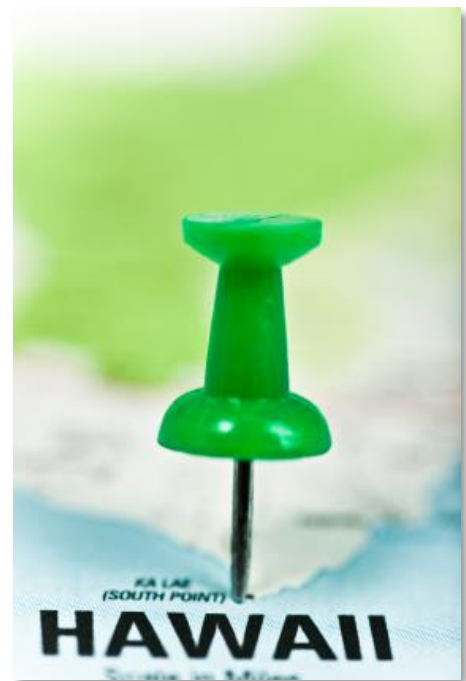
Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to Hawaii's Economy

In Hawaii there are **251,591** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 189,864 Retired Workers
- 23,174 Disabled Workers
- 15,197 Widow(er)s
- 8,821 Spouses
- 14,535 Children
