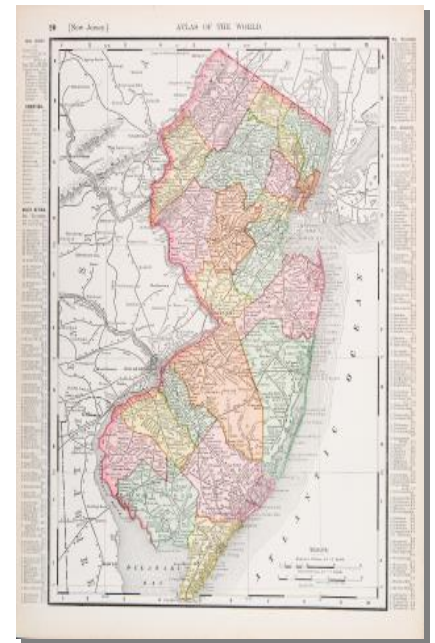
Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to New Jersey's Economy
