In Pennsylvania there are **2,722,892** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 1,814,793 Retired Workers
- 409,608 Disabled Workers
- 206,941 Widow(er)s
- 104,523 Spouses
- 187,027 Children

**Social Security benefits provide \$41 Billion Each year to Pennsylvania's economy**
