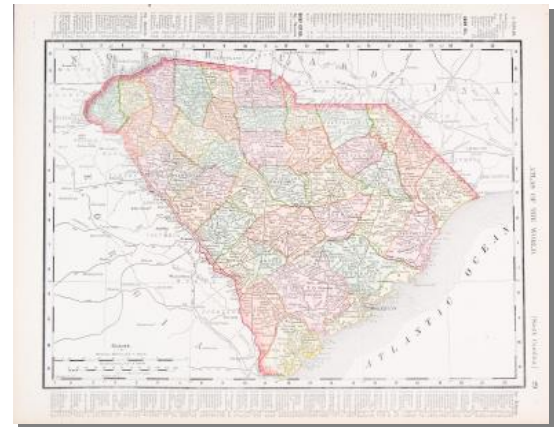
Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to South Carolina's Economy

In South Carolina there are **1,040,971** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 683,006 Retired Workers
- 179,872 Disabled Workers
- 68,220 Widow(er)s
- 29,216 Spouses
- 80,657 Children
