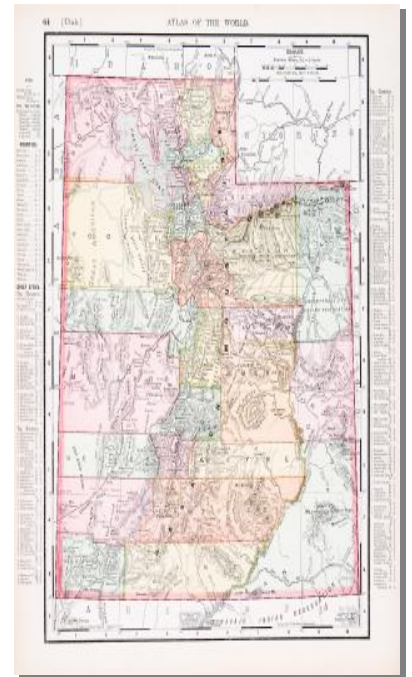
Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to Utah's Economy

In Utah there are **365,730** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 244,753 Retired Workers
- 47,947 Disabled Workers
- 22,946 Widow(er)s
- 18,457 Spouses
- 31,627 Children
