Did you know? Last summer when **Proposition 8 & Section 3 of DOMA** were overturned by the U.S. Supreme Court, married same-sex couples gained hundreds of federal benefits. Social Security benefits formerly reserved for heterosexual married couples and their children are now available to same-sex married couples. This is a significant development, which will have a very positive financial impact on the LGBT community. **At this town hall, national advocates will provide critical information on how this may affect you!**
