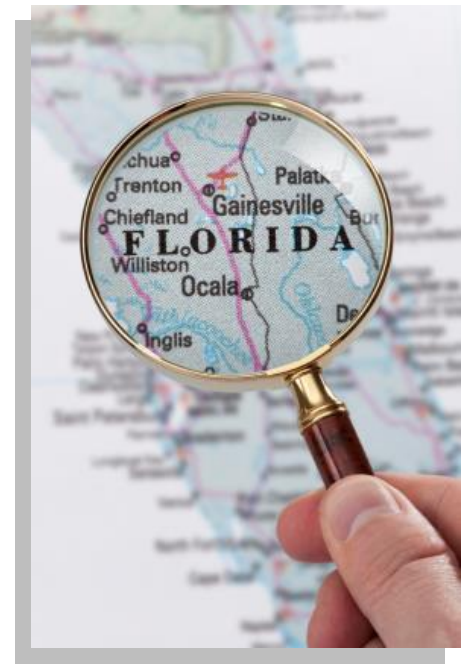
Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to Florida's Economy
