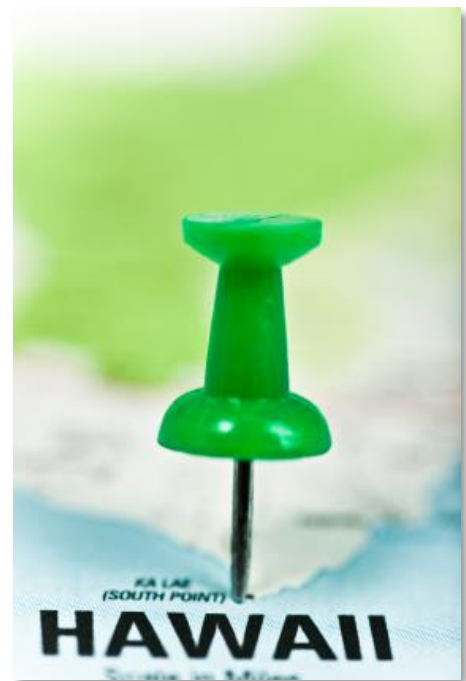
Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to Hawaii's Economy

In Hawaii there are **266,523** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 206,148 Retired Workers
- 21,813 Disabled Workers
- 14,924 Widow(er)s
- 9,678 Spouses
- 13,960 Children
