


# Social Security Snapshot

## Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to Kansas's Economy

In Kansas there are **544,486** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 380,624 Retired Workers
- 73,174 Disabled Workers
- 34,869 Widow(er)s
- 18,595 Spouses
- 37,224 Children

**Social Security benefits provide \$8 Billion Each year to Kansas's economy**
