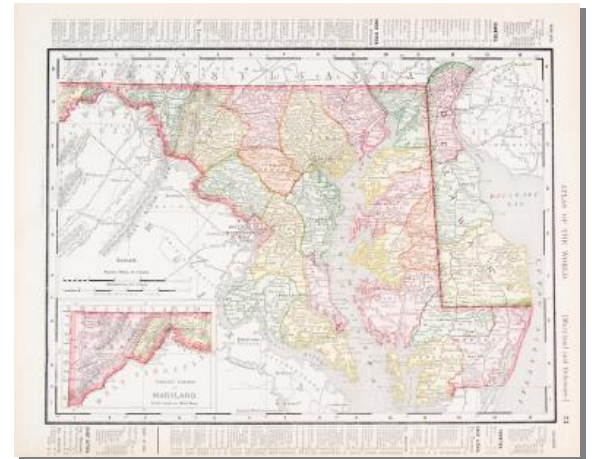
Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to Maryland's Economy

In Maryland there are **983,736** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 700,145 Retired Workers
- 129,481 Disabled Workers
- 57,916 Widow(er)s
- 32,950 Spouses
- 63,244 Children

Social Security benefits provide \$16 Billion Each year to Maryland's economy
