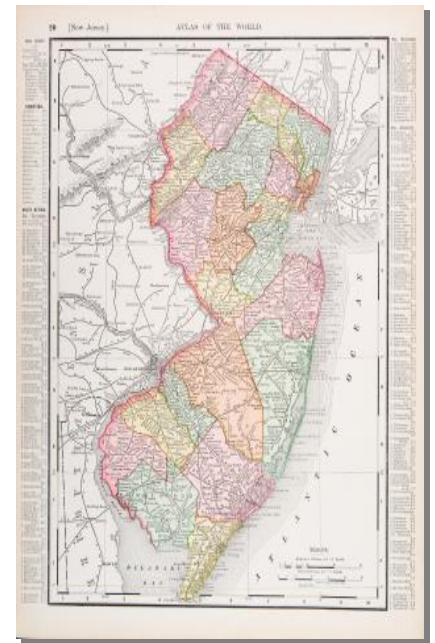
## Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to New Jersey's Economy

- 1,159,770 Retired Workers
- 196,663 Disabled Workers
- 95,826 Widow(er)s
- 61,673 Spouses
- 99,164 Children
