

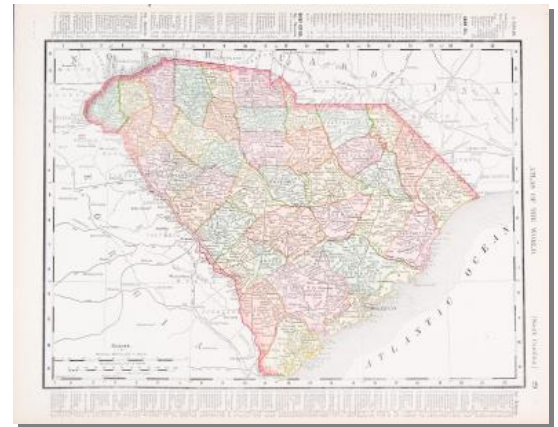
Social Security Snapshot

Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to South Carolina's Economy

In South Carolina there are **1,115,313** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 765,602 Retired Workers
- 174,597 Disabled Workers
- 67,759 Widow(er)s
- 29,683 Spouses
- 77,672 Children

Social Security benefits provide \$17 Billion Each year to South Carolina's economy
