Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to Hawaii's Economy

In Hawaii there are **277,013** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 218,219 Retired Workers
- 20,572 Disabled Workers
- 14,570 Widow(er)s
- 9,962 Spouses
- 13,690 Children

Social Security benefits provide \$4.6 Billion each year to Hawaii's economy
