In Kansas there are **561,634** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 402,018 Retired Workers
- 70,426 Disabled Workers
- 33,589 Widow(er)s
- 19,473 Spouses
- 36,128 Children

Social Security benefits provide \$9.6 Billion each year to Kansas's economy
