

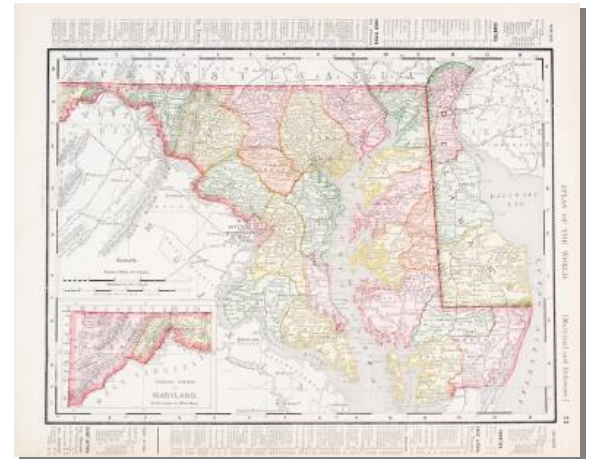
Social Security Snapshot

Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to Maryland's Economy

In Maryland there are **1,020,436** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 742,552 Retired Workers
- 124,843 Disabled Workers
- 56,217 Widow(er)s
- 34,003 Spouses
- 62,821 Children

Social Security benefits provide \$18 Billion each year to Maryland's economy
