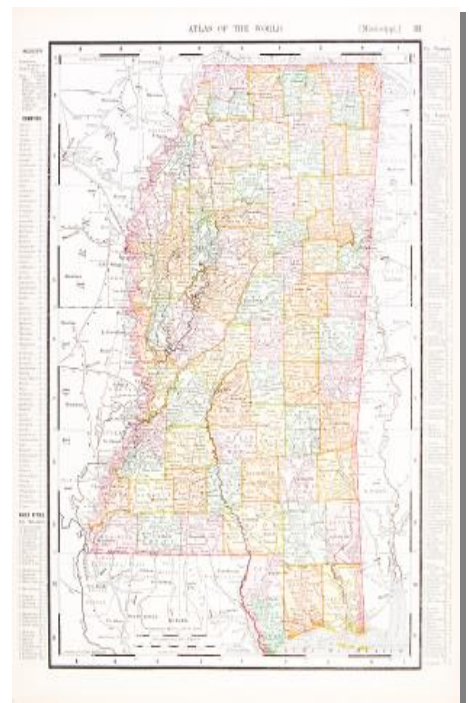
## Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to Mississippi's Economy

In Mississippi there are **677,464** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 429,412 Retired Workers
- 122,113 Disabled Workers
- 45,927 Widow(er)s
- 17,377 Spouses
- 62,635 Children

**Social Security benefits provide \$10 Billion each year to Mississippi's economy**
