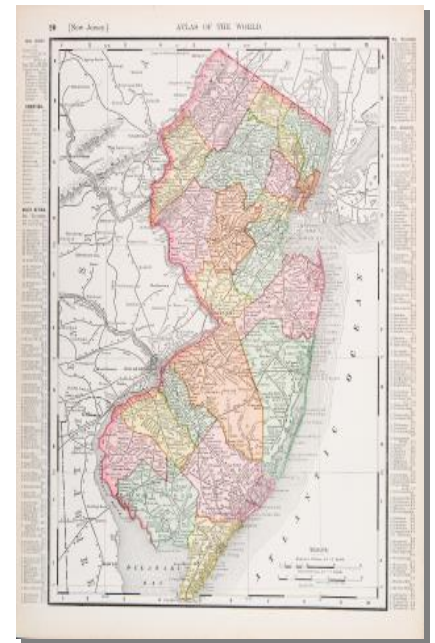
## Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to New Jersey's Economy

In New Jersey there are **1,646,792** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 1,207,715 Retired Workers
- 186,881 Disabled Workers
- 92,329 Widow(er)s
- 64,590 Spouses
- 95,277 Children
