In Oregon there are **891,726** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 662,320 Retired Workers
- 102,966 Disabled Workers
- 49,521 Widow(er)s
- 33,210 Spouses
- 43,709 Children

Social Security benefits provide \$15 Billion each year to Oregon's economy
