

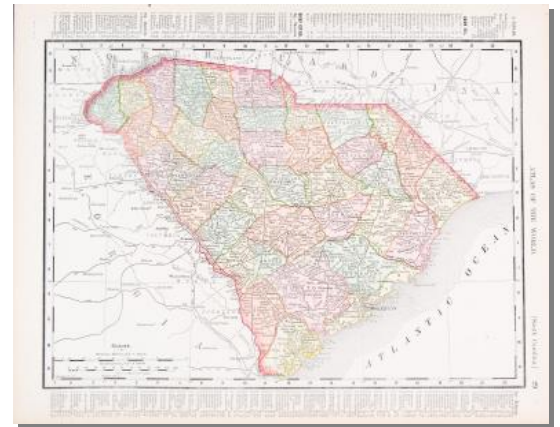
Social Security Snapshot

Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to South Carolina's Economy

In South Carolina there are **1,174,399** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 828,566 Retired Workers
- 171,174 Disabled Workers
- 67,311 Widow(er)s
- 30,678 Spouses
- 76,670 Children

Social Security benefits provide \$19 Billion each year to South Carolina's economy
