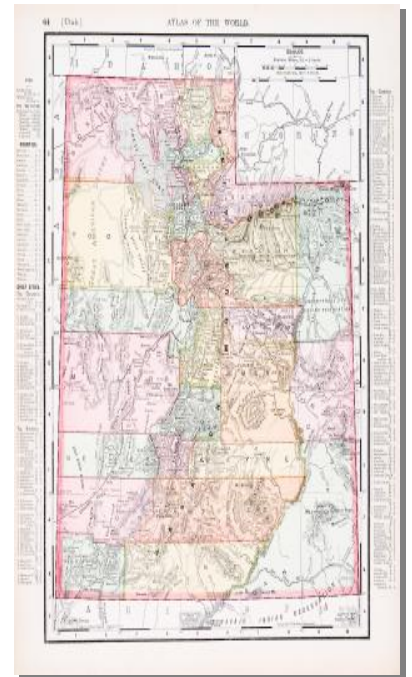
Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to Utah's Economy

In Utah there are **419,037** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 296,554 Retired Workers
- 45,483 Disabled Workers
- 23,543 Widow(er)s
- 21,915 Spouses
- 31,542 Children

Social Security benefits provide \$7.1 Billion each year to Utah's economy
