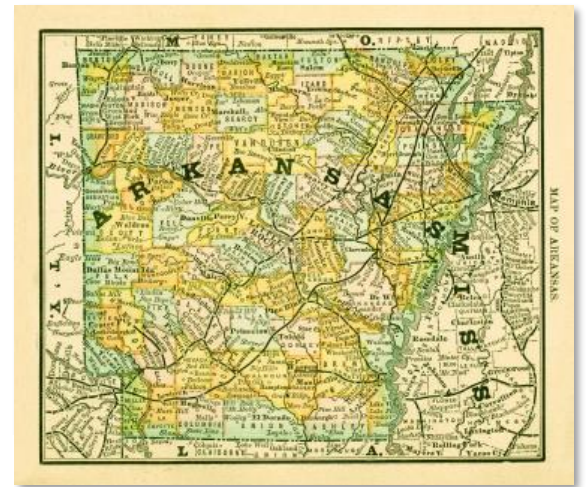
## Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to Arkansas's Economy

In Arkansas there are **707,846** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 460,240 Retired Workers
- 129,636 Disabled Workers
- 43,819 Widow(er)s
- 16,984 Spouses
- 57,167 Children

**Social Security benefits provide \$11 Billion each year to Arkansas's economy**
