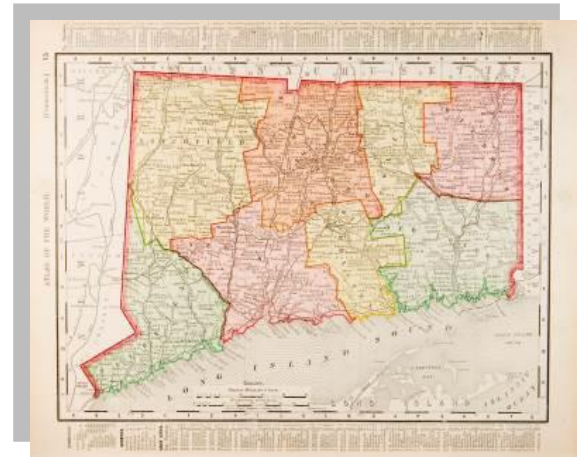
Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to Connecticut's Economy

In Connecticut there are **695,402** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 522,492 Retired Workers
- 76,746 Disabled Workers
- 35,653 Widow(er)s
- 22,136 Spouses
- 38,375 Children

Social Security benefits provide **\$13 Billion** each year to Connecticut's economy
