

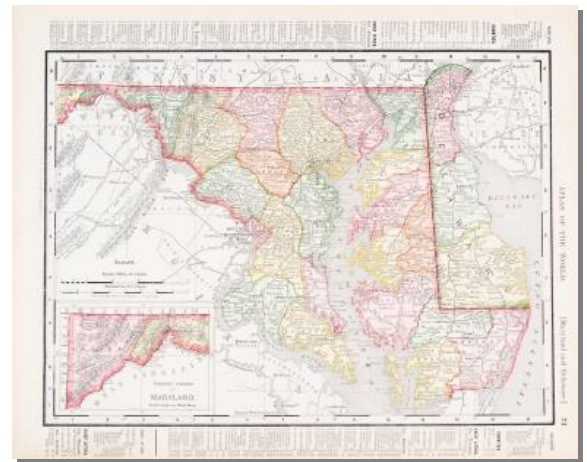
Social Security Snapshot

Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to Maryland's Economy

In Maryland there are **1,032,078** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 761,526 Retired Workers
- 121,139 Disabled Workers
- 54,909 Widow(er)s
- 32,312 Spouses
- 62,192 Children

Social Security benefits provide \$18 Billion each year to Maryland's economy
