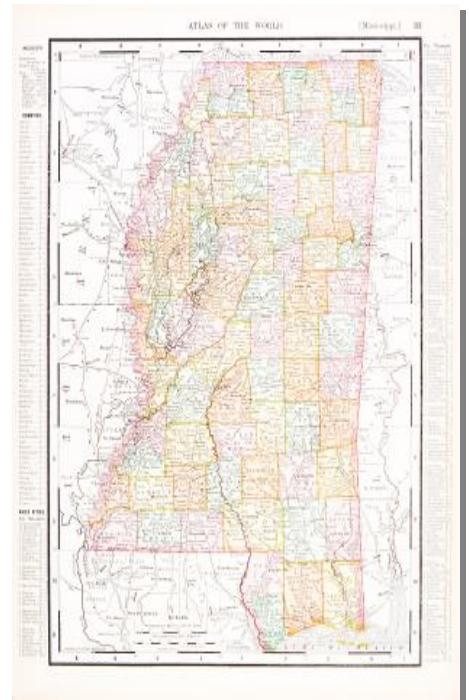
Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to Mississippi's Economy

In Mississippi there are **681,219** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 439,690 Retired Workers
- 118,358 Disabled Workers
- 44,889 Widow(er)s
- 16,396 Spouses
- 61,886 Children

Social Security benefits provide \$10 Billion each year to Mississippi's economy
