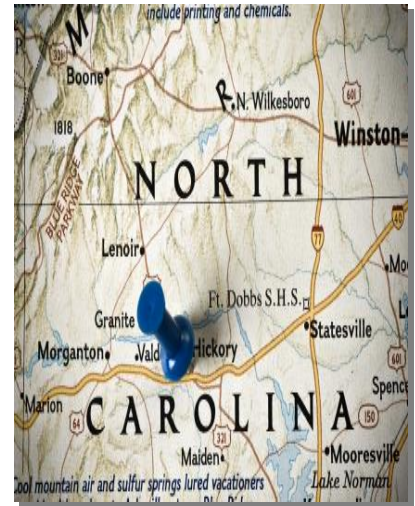
Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to North Carolina's Economy

In North Carolina there are **2,183,353** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 1,574,403 Retired Workers
- 306,204 Disabled Workers
- 115,589 Widow(er)s
- 51,757 Spouses
- 135,400 Children

Social Security benefits provide \$37 Billion each year to North Carolina's economy
