## Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to Oregon's Economy

In Oregon there are **906,127** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 683,497 Retired Workers
- 99,498 Disabled Workers
- 48,776 Widow(er)s
- 32,343 Spouses
- 43,013 Children

**Social Security benefits provide \$15 Billion each year to Oregon's economy**
