

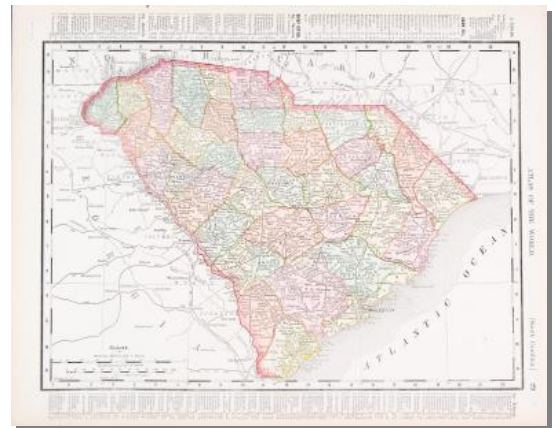
# Social Security Snapshot

## Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to South Carolina's Economy

In South Carolina there are **1,197,138** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 857,657 Retired Workers
- 166,551 Disabled Workers
- 66,989 Widow(er)s
- 29,375 Spouses
- 76,566 Children

**Social Security benefits provide \$20 Billion each year to South Carolina's economy**
