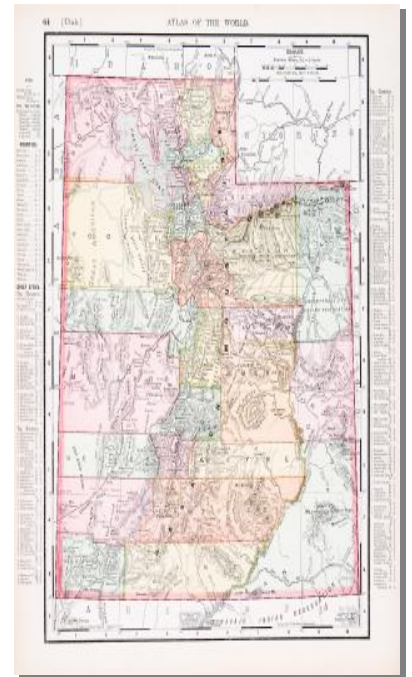
Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to Utah's Economy

In Utah there are **430,247** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 308,775 Retired Workers
- 44,846 Disabled Workers
- 23,686 Widow(er)s
- 21,456 Spouses
- 31,484 Children

Social Security benefits provide \$7 Billion Each year to Utah's economy
