In Virginia there are **1,585,194** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 1,147,511 Retired Workers
- 199,120 Disabled Workers
- 91,690 Widow(er)s
- 52,390 Spouses
- 94,479 Children

Social Security benefits provide \$28 Billion each year to Virginia's economy
