Reading the Scorecard

While members of Congress vote on an array of issues and no profile of a U.S. Representative or Senator is complete without consideration of all votes as well as work in committee and on constituent services, the National Committee legislative staff has identified votes in the 114th Congress (2015-2016) on issues it believes to be of particular importance to seniors.

Here’s how to use your members-only **Congressional Scorecard**. First, locate your State, then your Congressional District (CD) where you’ll see the name of your U.S. Representative. Next, locate your two U.S. Senators shown at the bottom of your State’s Scorecard section. Listed to the right of all their names are how they cast their votes on key bills, which are listed at the top of the page. Refer to list of “Votes Cast” to find out the title of the bill, how each bill could impact your earned benefits and your National Committee’s position.

A “Y” indicates a YES vote. An “N” indicates a NO vote. An “NV” indicates the member did not vote on the bill. A dash mark (“-”) indicates the vote took place before the member was sworn-in to his or her seat.

VOTES CAST IN THE UNITED STATES HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

HOUSE 2015 (First Session)

1. House Rule Against Disability Insurance Reallocation. (H.Res. 5) Adopting Rules for the 114th Congress – On Agreeing to the Resolution: A rule to prevent the House of Representatives from considering legislation to address the financing of the Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) Trust Fund unless accompanied by benefit cuts or tax increases that improve the solvency of the combined Old Age, Survivor and Disability Insurance Fund. The rule created an artificial crisis that could have resulted in Social Security retirement benefit cuts and a 19 percent cut in the Social Security benefits of 11 million workers with severe disabilities and their families. Roll Call #6, 1/6/15. **Passed: 234-172. National Committee position: No.**

2. Repeal of the Affordable Care Act. (H.R. 596) Repeal of the Affordable Care Act – On Passage of the Bill: This legislation would have repealed the Affordable Care Act. If the health reform law was repealed, seniors would lose discounts on brand-name prescription drugs, the Medicare Part D “donut hole” coverage gap would fully reappear, seniors would again be forced to pay for mammograms and other preventive care, and millions of “young seniors” from ages 50 to 64 would lose access to affordable private health insurance or expanded Medicaid coverage. Roll Call #58, 2/3/15. **Passed: 239-186. National Committee position: No.**

3. 2016 Budget Resolution. (H.Con.Res. 27) Fiscal Year 2016 Budget Resolution – On Agreeing to the Resolution, as amended: This budget would end traditional Medicare, increase the Medicare eligibility age, increase Medicare beneficiaries’ out-of-pocket costs, slash Medicaid funding (including long-term care coverage), and repeal Medicaid expansion. Roll Call #142, 3/25/2015. **Passed: 228-199. National Committee position: No.**

4. Trade Adjustment Assistance. (H.R. 1314) On concurring to a Senate amendment to the trade bill – This legislation would have cut Medicare to pay for non-Medicare programs, setting a dangerous precedent for using Medicare as a piggy bank. Roll Call #361, 6/12/15. **Failed: 126-302. National Committee position: No.**

HOUSE 2016 (Second Session)

5. Department of Labor Fiduciary Rule. (H.J.Res. 88) Disapproving the rule submitted by the Department of Labor relating to the definition of the term “Fiduciary” – On Passage: This resolution would block the implementation of a rule to require all financial professionals who provide retirement investment advice to put their clients’ best interests ahead of their own financial interests. This rule is intended to help Americans of all ages keep more of their hard-earned savings so they can enjoy a more financially secure and independent retirement. Roll Call #176, 4/28/16. **Passed: 234-183. National Committee position: No.**

VOTES CAST IN THE UNITED STATES SENATE

SENATE 2015 (First Session)

6. Amendment to Protect Medicare. (S.Amdt. 601 to S. Con. Res. 11) – On the Motion: This amendment would change Senate rules to protect Medicare against any legislation that would privatize the program, cut guaranteed benefits, or increase the amount seniors spend out-of-pocket on health care expenses. Roll Call #90, 3/25/15. **Failed: 46-53.** **National Committee position: Yes.**

7. Undermining the Affordable Care Act. (S.Amdt. 1114 to H.R. 2) – On the Amendment: This amendment would undermine the Affordable Care Act by repealing the individual mandate to purchase health insurance, thus endangering discounts on Medicare Part D brand-name prescription drugs, free preventive care services, access to affordable private health insurance, and expanded Medicaid for millions of “young seniors” from ages 50 to 64. Roll Call #137, 4/14/15. **Failed: 54-45.** **National Committee position: No.**

8. 2016 Budget Resolution Conference Report. (Conference Report to Accompany S.Con.Res. 11) – On the Conference Report: This budget agreement would shift more costs to Medicare beneficiaries, assumed the privatization of Medicare, assumed repeal of the Affordable Care Act, sharply reduced Medicaid funding (including long-term care coverage), and put at risk the Social Security Disability Insurance benefits of workers with severe disabilities. Roll Call #171, 5/5/15. **Passed: 51-48.** **National Committee position: No.**

SENATE 2016 (Second Session)

9. Department of Labor Fiduciary Rule. (H. J. Res. 88) – On the Joint Resolution: This Joint Resolution would block the implementation of a rule to require all financial professionals who provide retirement investment advice to put their clients’ best interests ahead of their own financial interests. This rule would help Americans of all ages keep more of their hard-earned savings so they can enjoy a more financially secure and independent retirement. Roll Call #84, 5/24/16. **Passed: 56-41.** **National Committee position: No.**
