Dear Friend,

The National Committee to Preserve Social Security and Medicare was founded in 1982 by former Congressman James Roosevelt, son of President Franklin D. Roosevelt, signer of the law that created Social Security. The National Committee is the nation's leading advocacy group fighting to protect Social Security and Medicare. We are a nonpartisan, nonprofit organization representing the views of millions of seniors. It is our mission to protect, preserve, promote and ensure the financial security, health and well-being of current and future generations of Americans.

It is also important that we educate seniors on how their Social Security, Medicare, Medicaid and other programs crucial to older Americans are impacted by congressional votes taken in Washington, DC. This **118th Congressional Scorecard** documents key House and Senate votes on Social Security and Medicare issues. Our legislative staff has taken the time to identify votes in the 118th Congress (2023-2024) on issues it believes to be of importance to seniors.

Most lawmakers understand that seniors are highly engaged and politically active. Yet, some of our elected officials talk about Social Security and Medicare as if these programs are expendable and should be used to pay down the national debt. They refuse to acknowledge that these programs are lifesaving for many older Americans. Some question whether seniors really deserve the benefits they've paid into for their entire working lives. And they propose cuts, changes to the eligibility ages, structural reforms, even privatization — all the while they fiercely protect massive tax breaks for the wealthy and huge corporations. That is why it is important now more than ever that you understand how your members of Congress voted on key legislation during this current 118th Congress.

Right now, we're preparing to face a renewed assault on your earned benefits in the new Congress next January, and by the "lame duck" session in November and December, when lawmakers could possibly try to fast track harmful bills to cut Social Security or Medicare. As we have seen in the past, almost anything can happen during this uncertain political time in Washington.

You can understand how critical these issues are — and the importance of knowing who is on your side ... and who is not! So please take a moment to review this Scorecard.

Of course, the other important thing is to stay involved with the National Committee. As always, we will be relying upon your high level of participation and support to see us through the challenges ahead.

Reading the Scorecard

The National Committee legislative staff has identified votes in the 118th Congress (2023-2024) on issues it believes to be of importance to seniors. This list is not intended to be a complete account of all the votes and activities of U.S. Representatives and Senators, but we feel it is instructive with regard to programs critical to older Americans.

Here is how to use our **118th Congressional Scorecard**. First, locate your State, then your Congressional District (CD), where you will see the name of your U.S. Representative. Next, locate your two U.S. Senators shown at the bottom of your State's Scorecard section. Listed to the right of all their names are how they cast their votes on key bills, which are listed at the top of the page. Refer to list of "Votes Cast" to find the title of the bill, how each bill could impact your earned benefits and the National Committee's position.

"Y" indicates a YES vote, "N" indicates a NO vote, and "NV" indicates the member did not vote on the bill. A dash mark ("-") indicates the vote took place before the member was sworn-in to his or her seat.

VOTES CAST IN THE UNITED STATES HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

U.S. HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 2023 (First Session)

1. **Cut Seniors Programs. (H.R. 2811) On passage of the bill:** Would have made severe funding cuts, beginning with a 22 percent decrease to all federal agencies, in exchange for increasing the debt ceiling. The cuts would have led to closures of numerous Social Security field offices, worsen Social Security and Medicare assistance wait times, and cut access to Older Americans Act programs like nutrition services, supportive services, family caregiver services, health promotion, disease prevention, in-home services and the long-term care ombudsman program. House Roll Call #199. April 26, 2023. **Passed 217-215. National Committee Position: No.**
2. **Fiscal Commission and Program Cuts. (H.R. 5525) On passage of the bill:** Would have cut federal spending by 30 percent, including important seniors' programs, and called for the establishment of a fiscal commission, leading to potential deep cuts to Social Security, Medicare, and Medicaid. House Roll Call #511. September 29, 2023. **Failed 198-232. National Committee Position: No.**
3. **Cut Nutrition and Food Security. (H.R. 4368) On passage of the bill:** Would have cut funding for food and nutrition programs back to 2007 levels, cutting \$8 billion from 2023. It threatened the ability to produce a safe, abundant and affordable food supply, as well as medicine and medical devices. House Roll Call #507. September 29, 2023. **Failed 191-237. National Committee Position: No.**

VOTES CAST IN THE UNITED STATES SENATE

U.S. SENATE 2023 (First Session)

4. **Automatic Spending Cuts. (Senate Amendment 91 to H.R. 3746) On voting on an amendment offered by Senator Mike Braun (R-IN):** Would have imposed a one percent across-the-board spending cut, including reductions to critical older Americans programs, every 30 days if H.R. 3746 (debt ceiling deal) had not passed. Senate Roll Call #137. June 1, 2023. **Failed 35-62. National Committee Position: No.**
5. **Agency Funding. (Senate Amendment 106 to H.R. 3746) On voting on an amendment offered by Senator Tom Cotton (R-AR):** Would have required non-defense federal spending to face future cuts. As a result, severe cuts would have been made to critical services that seniors depend on including health care, housing and transportation. Senate Roll Call #142. June 1, 2023. **Failed 48- 51. National Committee Position: No.**
6. **Federal Government Funding. (Senate Amendment 1366 to H.R. 6363) On voting on an amendment offered by Senator Rand Paul (R-KY):** Would have reduced non-defense federal agency funding by 15 percent. The cuts would severely impact older Americans programs. Senate Roll Call #311. November 15, 2023. **Failed 32-65. National Committee Position: No.**
